The Spanish Mathematics Committee, representing Spain as an adhering organization of the International Mathematical Union (IMU), expresses its full support for the joint bid of Dublin and Glasgow to host the IMU General Assembly in 2030, followed by the International Congress of Mathematicians (ICM).

We acknowledge the exceptional work done by the Advisory Board in preparing this bid, which draws on the expertise of organizers from past ICM editions. This experience guarantees a well-organized and successful event.

Both the United Kingdom and Ireland have a rich tradition in mathematical science, and their strong track record in organizing major scientific events is a solid foundation for the success of this bid. We are confident that their combined capabilities will ensure the smooth running of both the General Assembly and the ICM.

Furthermore, we believe it is time to bring the ICM back to Europe after more than two decades since the last European edition, held in Madrid in 2006.
